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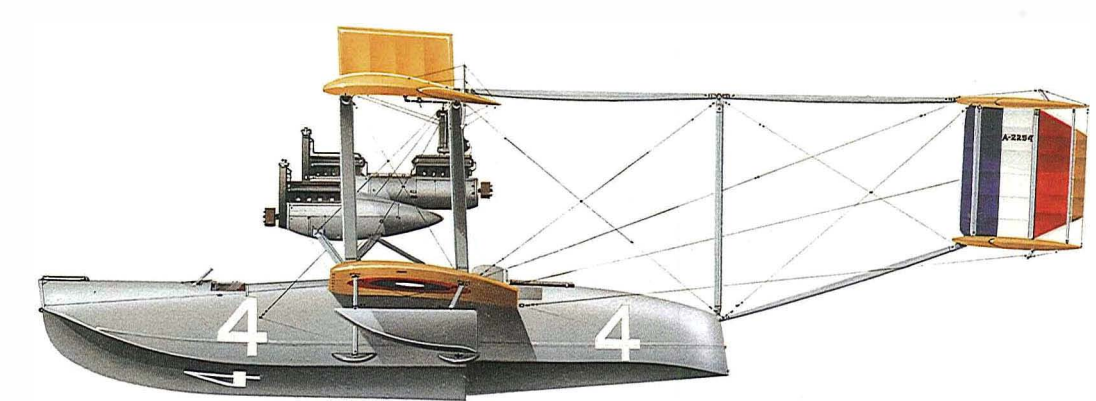

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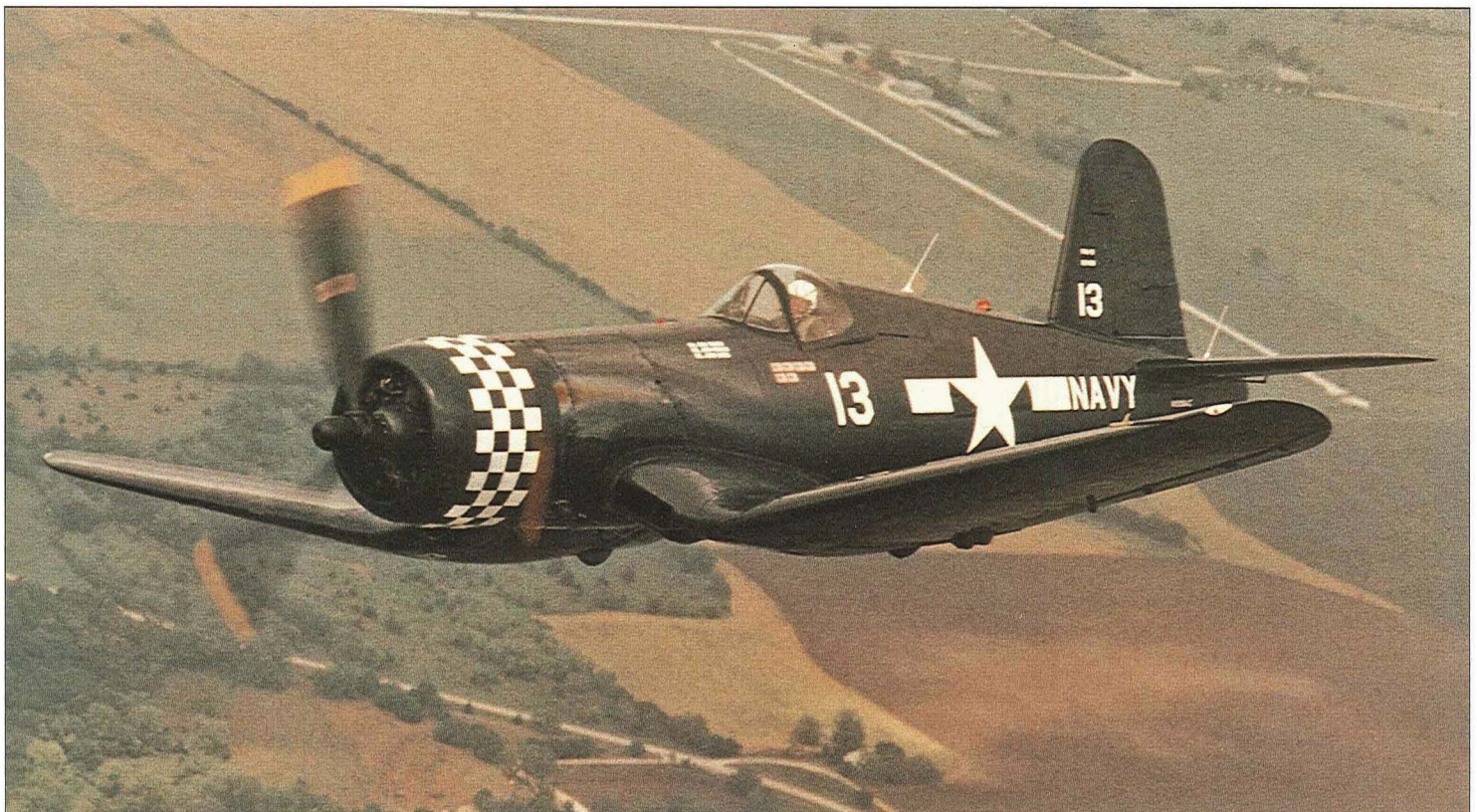
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Known as 'Whistling Death' to the Japanese, the Vought F4U Corsair also performed with distinction in the Korean War.

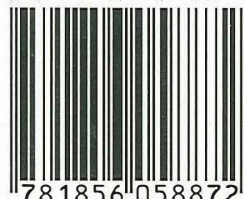
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
